DRIVING HIGH AND THE CONSEQUENCES

THE CONSEQUENCES OF DRIVING HIGH

- Driving Under the Influence (DUI) penalties apply when driving under the influence of marijuana, alcohol, and/or any other drug. The consequences may include:
 - Fines up to \$1000;
 - Jail time for up to 6 months;
 - · DUI classes for up to 9 months;
 - CA driver license suspension up to 10 months.
- Marijuana use can increase the risk of crashes by slowing down reaction time and by affecting judgment of time and distance.
- Anyone under 18 years of age who is caught with marijuana can be given a fine, counseling, and community service.
- The possession or use of marijuana can lead to a violation of probation or parole.
